POLICY:

The Corporation of the Township of Georgian Bay will endeavor to meet all reasonable accessibility needs relating to public transportation. Currently, the Township does not operate any public transit systems; and there are currently no Taxi Cab licenses issued in the Township of Georgian Bay. When modes of public transit become available, they will be required to adhere to established policies, practices and procedures of the Township.

PROCEDURES:

When the Township of Georgian Bay begins to provide public transportation, the municipality shall publish its' practices and procedures regarding accessible transportation initiatives in practical locations (bus stops, cab visors, bus terminal) and on the municipal web site. The practices and procedures may include;

- having transportation operators or guides verbally announce routes, directions, destinations and major stops.
- ensuring that there are no additional fees or charges applied to people with disabilities to store or transport their wheelchairs, canes and walkers etc. when using municipal public transit
- providing alternate means of transportation to persons with disabilities in the event that the usual mode of transportation accessed is unavailable due to mechanical or labour difficulties.

The Township will provide a means of transportation users to provide feedback as to how the transportation service may be improved, or to address needs that have not been recognized in procedures or practices.
