The Township of Georgian Bay is a growing water-based community located in the District of Muskoka along the eastern shore of beautiful Georgian Bay. The Township has a permanent resident population of approximately 2,500 and an additional seasonal population of approximately 15,000.

Working under the direction of the Director of Operations, the Day Camp Counsellors will plan and implement activities for the summer camp to ensure that the needs of each participant are met and that the principles of High Five Healthy Childhood Development are achieved.

Working Conditions: The Summer camp operates out of MacTier. Counsellors are required to work both indoors and outdoors pending weather. Some activities are hosted at the community centers and waterfronts.

Summary of Duties:

- Understand and implement the HIGH FIVE principles of healthy child development in a professional environment
- Responsible for a high quality day camp program for individuals and groups
- Responsible for continuous supervision of all campers when assigned to a group and during whole camp activities
- Develop positive and supportive communications and relationships with the children, parents, camp staff and volunteers, park staff and the community
- Maintain waterfront safety equipment

Required Qualifications:

- Will be 16 years of age or older by December 31, 2019
- Valid First Aid and CPR Level C required
- Experience in the implementation of children's programming in large group settings
- Reliable means of transportation to get to and from work
- Current Vulnerable Sector Screening (for those 18 years of age and over)
- Good customer service and communication skills
- NLS certification required, Swim Instructor Certification an asset

Hourly Rate: \$15.39 per hour plus 4% vacation pay. 40 hour work week, Monday to Friday.
