



## Night Road Patrol Competition #2021-18

**Overview:** The Township of Georgian Bay is looking for a Night Road Patroller to join our team on a temporary, seasonal contract which will run from November 2021 to April 2022. Under minimal supervision, the Night Road Patrol position is responsible for patrolling Township roads during the winter season for road conditions and other hazards to ensure that the roads are safe for vehicles and in compliance with Provincial Minimum Maintenance Standards.

### **Duties include but are not limited to:**

- Monitor weather conditions in accordance with the Guideline for Winter Weather Monitoring through the Ontario Good Roads Association.
- Patrol Township of Georgian Bay and District of Muskoka Roads in general conformance with the Ontario Good Roads Association's Guidelines for Patrolling Representative Roads in winter, as well as the Township and District Winter Control Plans.
- Complete detailed road surface condition reports and make decisions on whether the roadway requires winter maintenance in accordance with the Ontario Minimum Maintenance Standards and Township and District of Muskoka guidelines.
- Document and provide information to the Operations Supervisor regarding areas for repair and non-compliance.
- Operate snowplow and/or sanding and salting trucks to remove ice and snow from roads, as required.
- Maintain assigned vehicles in a clean and tidy condition; make daily inspections; record deficiencies. May make minor repairs as required.
- Personally comply with all health and safety practices as they relate to the work, standard operating guidelines, and the Occupational Health and Safety Act. Wear personal protective equipment, as required. Report hazards to respective Supervisor.

### **Knowledge/experience:**

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Minimum of two (2) years' road maintenance experience, with one (1) year related truck driving experience
- Must possess a valid DZ Driver's License, in good standing
- Thorough knowledge of all applicable Provincial and Municipal Regulations and standards including, but not limited to, the Provincial Minimum Maintenance Standards and Occupational Health and Safety Act

**Wage rate:** \$19.41 (probationary rate of pay) to \$19.99 per hour plus 4% vacation pay. This temporary, seasonal position will run from November 2021 to April 2022. The successful candidate must have the ability to work flexible hours, including nights and weekends.
