



## What is this?

An approved waterfront plan that includes upgrades to Delawana Road for residents and guests to enjoy for years to come.

## Where is this?

The entire project is in Honey Harbour and is right on the Township owned Delawana Road.

## What is in the plan?

There are 4 components:

1. A large dock at the end of Delawana Road;
2. Several small docks and boat slips for day use only;
3. A walking path along the shore of Georgian Bay;
4. Upgrades to the beach/parkette at the intersection of Honey Harbour Road and Delawana Road for residents and visitors to be able to enjoy this space.
