The Township of Georgian Bay is a growing water-based community located in the District of Muskoka along the eastern shore of beautiful Georgian Bay. The Township has a permanent resident population of approximately 3,500 and an additional seasonal population of around 17,500. Overview: We are looking for a Parks Labourer (Summer Student) to join our Operations Department team. This hands-on role is perfect for those who enjoy working outdoors and contributing to the upkeep of our parks, trails, and facilities.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Maintain Township parks, trails, and gardens through grass cutting, trimming, watering, weeding, and planting.
- Upkeep of beach areas, parks, and public spaces, pickleball courts, and more. This includes garbage/recycling collection and washroom maintenance.
- Assist with event set-up in our parks and facilities.
- Perform minor maintenance tasks such as painting, small repairs, or janitorial duties.

Working Conditions: This position will require travel throughout the Township and outdoor work in variable weather conditions. Physical activity includes walking, kneeling, and lifting (up to 45 lbs).

Knowledge/experience:

- Currently enrolled or recently graduated from secondary or post-secondary education.
- Valid Ontario Drivers Licence and acceptable drivers abstract (to be provided upon hire).
- Reliable, punctual, and able to manage time effectively.
- Standard First Aid and CPR Certification is considered an asset.
- Experience with lawn maintenance equipment is considered an asset.

Wage rate: \$19.60 per hour, based on a 40-hour workweek. The work schedule may include days, evenings, and weekend work.
